FOOTBALL 7 TOURNAMENT

Each team will have a maximum of 12 players and all of them must be (at least) 18 years old.

- Each team must designate a CAPTAIN, and it will be the sole responsibility of the team to notify of any relevant information or any last minute communication for the execution of the tournament.
- The exact nature of the format will be decided by the number of teams who enter. The full fixture will be delivered once the registration deadline expires.
- The tournament will consist of a Qualifying Phase, minor finals, semifinals and final. The game system and schemes of Qualifying Phase will be sent to the captains 3 days before the start of the Tournament to their email once the registration is closed.
- Scoring system:
 - Won game: 3 points
 - Tied match: 1 point
 - Lost game: 0 points
- Qualifying system: Teams with the highest score will qualify for the next round in the Qualifying Round. In the event of a tie between 2 or more teams in the Qualifying Round, the tiebreaker will be counted:
 - First, the points obtained in the matches played between the teams tied;
 - Second, the particular goal average between teams tied;
 - Third, the general goal average;
 - Fourth, the first in goals scored.
 - If the tie still persists, the team with the lowest score will be placed ahead.
- If at the end of the semi-final or final matches the result is a tie, the tie-breaker will proceed with the penalty kick. There will be a round of 3 penalties per team and if still persist the tie, it will continue by system of sudden death. The championship teams and runner-up of the tournament will be awarded with a trophy.

AFTER THE FIRST ROUND AND BEFORE THE DISPUTE OF THE SEMIFINALS, THE CELEBRATION OF AN INDEPENDENT PENALTY TOURNAMENT WILL BE ANNOUNCED OVER THE TANNOY. THIS WILL BE CELEBRATED IF THERE ARE ENOUGH PLAYERS.
